
Market Hall Rehabilitation



The following project is located in the state of São Paulo, Brazil in Itapira. The city is located at 643m above sea level it has an area of 518 Km² an a population of 75000. Itapira is characterized by its agriculture growing oranges, sugar-cane, cattle and (now-declining) coffee but is also a manufacturing center, specializing in wood and paper products, agricultural machinery, and ethanol production. The project site is located downtown. Currently in the 2180m² plot stands a city landmark, the market hall wich was built in 1954. During the first decades it was not only a place where farmers and local producers were selling their goods but also of socialization of the city's inhabitants. Now a days, mainly non-natural goods are sold and fairs take place twice every week during the evening where local farmers sales of natural goods take place.

The building currently has 2 levels. The upper level, accessible through R. Bento da Rocha







